CASEVILLE SCHOOL SPECIAL ELECTION – AUGUST 6, 2019. The school has a bond request. For more info (989) 856-2311

CITY GENERAL ELECTION - NOVEMBER 5, 2019. City Election – Mayor (2 year term) and three Councilmember's (4 year term) seats open. Contact the City office if you'd like to run. The City will also have a pest control millage request.

Absent Voter Ballots are available for each election. **PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST:** Forms are available at City hall to be on the permanent absent voter list. If you are on the permanent list, you will automatically have an absent voter **application** sent to you for every election in the future. (After filling out each application, we will give you a ballot!) Include your name, registered address and mailing address. For those who use a PO Box, please include that information in your request.

BRUSH PICK-UP: 1st Wednesday of each month April thru November
Light yard work & trimming. Set branches out with cut end to the curb. Call (989) 856-4407 with questions.

GRASS CLIPPINGS: Please do not put grass clippings on the streets or sidewalks, this is not allowed by ordinance and it causes problems with the storm drains.

GRASS AND WEEDS MAINTENANCE: Please cut the lawn or make arrangements to do it. If the City mows, the bill begins at \$200 per hour. Support a local mowing business instead.

RESERVE A PAVILION for special events. The City has 3 pavilions:

DiVincentis Park (Water Tower), Memorial Park on Main Street, and Pointe Park by the Breakwall.

PARK RESERVATION FEE is \$50 (City resident) and \$75 (non-resident). The fee includes a refundable deposit of \$25 which may be returned after a site inspection by the DPW.

DREDGING: You may have notice a dredge by the Breakwall. The Army Corp. of Engineers has contracted with a company to remove over 20,000 cubic yards of material. This project is controlled and funded entirely by the Federal government. We know the water is high, but this was scheduled a few years ago and its purpose is to remove the sand that has "drifted" in along the Breakwall potentially blocking navigation.

HIGH WATER: The lake is at near-record highs. If you need sand for sand bags, we have some. Contact Troy (989) 856-4407.

Utility Bills (Contact us to set up email billing and information on how to pay your account online)

Pay ½ of the Utility Bill by July 25th and the rest by August 26th without late fees. Pay the "amount due" on the bottom of the first sheet of the bill, that is the total owed. If you used water, but you're NOT billed for consumption, call the Water Plant to have your meter checked. If you wait you will have to pay for the consumption all at once when an actual reading is obtained.

WE NEED YOUR PHONE NUMBER! This helps us to contact you for emergencies (water leaks, frozen pipes, etc.)

REPORT WATER LEAKS - IF YOU SEE OR HEAR WATER running in a building or see standing water on a lot where it usually does not pool, PLEASE CALL THE WATER DEPT (989) 856-4407.
