GENERAL ELECTION - NOVEMBER 7, 2017. Don't forget to vote! Currently on the ballot is a millage request for 2 mils for City streets, one Mayor seat and three Council member seats. Candidates that filled by July 25th are as follows: Patricia Des Jardins is running for Mayor. Debra Estep, Jerald Ignash, Kenneth Rathje, Christopher Stahl & Todd Talaski are running for the 3 Council seats. Absent Voter Ballots are available for each election. PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST: Forms are available at City hall to be on the permanent absent voter list. If you are on the permanent list, you will automatically have an absent voter application sent to you for every election in the future. (After filling out each application, we will give you a ballot!) Include your name, registered address and mailing address. For those who use a PO Box, please include that information in your request.

TRASH COLLECTION SCHEDULE:

The City's collection day is MONDAY.

Emterra does not collect on Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. When holiday is on Monday, collection is the next day.

City Residents can drop off up to 1 yard of trash per month at the landfill for free. The landfill is located on McMillan Road. between W.

McTaggart and W. Atwater Roads

Utility Bills (Contact us to set up email billing and online auto payments)

Pay ½ Of the Utility Bill by October 25th and the rest by November 27th without late fees. Pay the "amount due" on the bottom of the first sheet of the bill, that is the total owed. If you used water, but you're NOT billed for consumption, call the Water Plant to have your meter checked. If you wait you will have to pay for the consumption all at once when an actual reading is obtained. WE NEED YOUR PHONE NUMBER! This helps us to contact you for emergencies (water leaks, frozen pipes, etc.)

REPORT WATER LEAKS - IF YOU SEE OR HEAR WATER running in a building or see standing water on a lot where it usually does not pool, PLEASE CALL THE WATER DEPT 856-4407.

Sewer OM&R (Operation Maintenance & Repair) base rates increased July 1st \$2.00 & Sewer OM&R usage rates increased \$.30 per thousand gallons July 1st.
