## ELECTIONS

**SPECIAL ELECTION** – AUGUST 8, 2017. Huron County millage renewal requests for their Veteran, Older Citizen & Transit millages.

**GENERAL ELECTION** - NOVEMBER 7, 2017. City Election – Mayor (2 year term) and three Councilmember's (4 year term) seats open.

There is also a millage request for 2 mils for 5 years for City streets.

Absent Voter Ballots are available for each election. **PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST:** Forms are available at City hall to be on the permanent absent voter list. If you are on the permanent list, you will automatically have an absent voter **application** sent to you for every election in the future. (After filling out each application, we will give you a ballot!) Include your name, registered address and mailing address. For those who use a PO Box, please include that information in your request.

**BRUSH PICK-UP:** 1st Wednesday of each month April thru November

Light yard work & trimming. Set branches out with cut end to the curb. Call (989) 856-4407 with questions.

**GRASS CLIPPINGS:** Please do not put grass clippings on the streets or sidewalks, this is not allowed by ordinance and it causes problems with the storm drains.

**GRASS AND WEEDS MAINTENANCE:** Please cut the lawn or make arrangements to do it. If the City mows, the bill begins at \$200 per hour. Support a local mowing business instead.

**RESERVE A PAVILION** for special events. The CITY has 3 pavilions:

DiVincentis Park (Water Tower), Memorial Park on Main Street, and Point Park by the Breakwall.

**PARK RESERVATION FEE** is \$50 (city resident) and \$75 (non-resident). The fee includes a refundable deposit of \$25 which may be returned after a site inspection by the DPW.

**PERMITS:** Here's a list of who to see for what permit: When in doubt, ask. Home Improvements & Building Permits are handled by our Zoning Administrator/Building Inspector, Terry Kelly (989) 856-2102. Also Site Plan Reviews and Zoning Variances. We have just added Raymond Heins for electrical permits and inspections. Garage Sales City Office (989) 856-2012. Up to 5/year; Cost: no charge for 1st permit; \$2.00 per additional permit. Outside Assembly, Entertainment & Vendor Permits Chief Romzek at (989) 856-3304.

## Utility Bills (Contact us to set up email billing and online auto payments)

Pay ½ Of the Utility Bill by July 25th and the rest by August 25th without late fees. Pay the "amount due" on the bottom of the first sheet of the bill, that is the total owed. If you used water, but you're NOT billed for consumption, call the Water Plant to have your meter checked. If you wait you will have to pay for the consumption all at once when an actual reading is obtained.

**WE NEED YOUR PHONE NUMBER!** This helps us to contact you for emergencies (water leaks, frozen pipes, etc.)

**REPORT WATER LEAKS** - IF YOU SEE OR HEAR WATER running in a building or see standing water on a lot where it usually does not pool, PLEASE CALL THE WATER DEPT (989) 856-4407.

Sewer OM&R (Operation Maintenance & Repair) base rates were increased \$2.00 per quarter July 1st and Sewer OM&R usage rates will increase \$.30 per thousand gallons July 1st. This will increase a customer's bill roughly \$14 per year (based on a consumption of 5,000 gallons per quarter).
