

Ordinance Committee

8-4-2015

Meeting started at 9:04 a.m.

The committee reviewed ordinance chapter 208, which deals with purchases. They recommended the limits be adopted by Council for “Self Purchase” \$0 to \$2,500, “Informal Purchase” \$2,501 to \$10,000, “Formal Purchase Limit” \$10,001 to \$20,000 and “Excess of Formal” over \$20,000. They were all in favor of this, and presenting a rewording of several parts of this chapter.

The committee recommended to the Council the changing of chapter 220, which involves Council pay. They recommended putting in language that allows Council members to opt out of being paid, if they choose, with Council approval. All were in favor of this.

Quinn and Romzek discussed parking on the streets and the need to start enforcing violations for overnight parking.

The Committee called in Terry Kelly and they discussed the issues with signs on the sidewalks and signs in need of repair, and the need to start enforcing the sign violations.

Terry discussed the camping (662.03) and storage of recreational vehicles (1286.15 (e)) ordinances. He recommended to the committee to put in wording for consecutive days for the 14 day per year requirement in the storage ordinance. He also requested the camping ordinance have this 14 consecutive day requirement and clarify some wording regarding access to the houses with water. The committee was all in favor of this.

The committee also discussed adding to Chapter 278 an ordinance for tree removal on private property when they are a hazard to others property. The committee was all in favor of adding this ordinance and sending it to John Ferris after the first reading.
