Reports: Quinn introduced Troy Hartz to the board and stated he feels Troy will do a fine job. Quinn reported that one of his DPW workers are off on sick leave, not sure of a return time.

Steve Corrion had to leave at 3:15p.m., due to an emergency.

Zolin stated that he has not seen as many zebra mussels as he seen a year ago.

Arthur inquired on who does their pump repair, and Quinn advised Northern Pump & Well.
